We are writing on behalf of the intervener Mosquito First Nation (the "MFN"). The MFN agrees with the applicants Algoquin to Adirondacks Collaborative and Aroland First Nation that the scope of factors for the environmental assessment of the project should be expanded to include the points in the applicants' submissions, particularly point #3 concerning site-specific emergency response plans. The MFN also agrees with the "Specific Aboriginal Procurement Plans" as laid out in point #4.

The project in large part includes the re-utilization of a natural gas pipeline. As such, the ERP's for those portions of the Project that repurpose and reutilize existing pipe can only be prepared following a determination by the Board of the "fit for use" of these existing pipeline sections.
