Subject: Award of Firm Service Capacity (General Terms and Conditions Article 9.1) – methodology change to Alliance Pipeline Tariff

Encana Corporation (Encana) is submitting this letter to the National Energy Board (NEB) in support of the proposed tariff changes by Alliance Pipeline (Alliance), for changes to the methodology for the Award of Firm Service Capacity, Relocations and FRGS (General Terms and Conditions Article 9.1). Encana supports the awarding of this service based on the term bid for the service, when demand for firm service capacity potentially exceeds availability, as an alternative to the current methodology which awards on a "first come, first served basis".

Encana submits that the awarding of firm service based on term more appropriately values the available capacity and benefits Alliance by potentially increasing the term contracted for any attrition capacity. Encana requests that the NEB approve the changes as written, as quickly as possible, to facilitate a potential open season on March 9, 2017 for attrition capacity available starting April 1, 2017, on Alliance's system.
