On February 3, 2017, the National Energy Board issued a letter soliciting comments by noon February 10, 2017 on Alliance's Application for approval of an amendment to the General Terms and Conditions of Alliance's tariff. The amendment would allow Alliance to suspend, from time to time, the first come, first served approach in the awarding of long-term firm service capacity on the Alliance Pipeline and replace it with an open season process.
