## **CONSULTATION MATTERS SUMMARY**

- **C1:** The consultation program for the Project is guided by TransCanada's *Stakeholder Commitment Statement* and TransCanada's corporate values of safety, integrity, innovation and collaboration. This *Commitment Statement* has been previously submitted to the National Energy Board.
- **C3-2:** On January 20, 2017 TransCanada distributed Project information packages to residents and businesses within an approximate 1 km radius of the Project site. To date, no issues or concerns have been raised.
- **C3-4:** TransCanada confirms that all potentially-affected Municipalities have been notified of the Project. To date, no issues or concerns have been raised.
- C3-5 and C3-6: TransCanada has consulted with provincial and federal regulatory agencies and will continue to engage with these agencies on an ongoing basis. All required permits will be obtained prior to construction and associated conditions and mitigations will be implemented.
- C4: As a result of the stakeholder outreach to date, TransCanada is not aware of any outstanding issues or concerns with the Project. TransCanada will continue to notify all stakeholders about the Project and address issues and concerns throughout the regulatory process and construction. Once construction is completed, regionally based TransCanada liaisons will continue to build and maintain relationships through consistent and ongoing communication with stakeholders.
