ENVIRONMENT AND SOCIO-ECONOMIC ASSESSMENT SUMMARY

The scope of the Project is small in scale, with a limited work force and short duration (six weeks). No adverse residual environmental or socio-economic effects are anticipated as a result of the proposed decommissioning activities (the Project).

The Project is located within the Alida Terminal. The Project will be limited to the operational footprint within the existing fence line (i.e., no additional land is required). All potentially affected industry third parties were notified by Westpur. To date, no issues or concerns have been identified.

Pursuant to Guide A, Section A.2 of the NEB's Filing Manual, all environmental and socio-economic matters were considered during preparation of the section 45 Application. Based on the nature of the project and activities, and the planned mitigation described in the Interactions Table (see Appendix 3), the environmental and socio-economic assessment for the Project determined that no adverse residual environmental or socio-economic effects are anticipated as a result of the Project. However, although unlikely, there is potential for project interactions arising from accidents and malfunctions. Measures outlined in the Corporate Environmental Guidelines for Construction, Emergency Response Plan, and associated contingency and management plans, will help to reduce the likelihood and consequence of any unplanned events arising from accidents and malfunctions.
