**Enbridge Pipelines Inc. request for revised interim toll methodology approval on
Line 9 for the period of 1 January 2008 to 30 April 2009**

The Board has received Enbridge's 21 May 2009 letter, including its proposal for revising past interim tolls and comments concerning an expected timeframe to file final tolls for 2008, 2009, and 2010. The Board notes that Enbridge's letter was in response to the Board's letter of 1 May 2009 providing an opportunity for shippers and other interested persons to comment on interim tolls for 1 January 2008 to 30 April 2009 and NOVA Chemicals' comments concerning 2008 final tolls contained in its letter of 27 April 2009. No comments were received from other parties.

The Board has reviewed Enbridge's proposed methodology for revised interim tolls for 1 January 2008 to 30 April 2009. The Board has also considered the letter from NOVA Chemicals. Taking into account that the methodology proposed by Enbridge is consistent with that approved by the Board in its interim toll order effective 1 May 2009 and noting that methodology is not based on the Transportation Service Agreement from the RH-3-2008 proceeding, the Board approves this revised interim methodology. The Board also notes that Enbridge stated in its letter that if the methodology is approved it will file an application for new interim tolls and a true-up calculation for this entire time period by 15 June 2009.

In the 27 April 2009 letter from NOVA Chemicals it requested the Board to take appropriate steps to require Enbridge to finalize 2008 tolls as soon as possible. The Board notes that in its letter of 21 May 2009, Enbridge stated that all cost information for 2008 is not yet known and it anticipates filing an application for final tolls for 2008, 2009 and 2010 in September 2009. If Enbridge is unable to meet this timeframe it is directed to file a letter with the Board and interested parties explaining the reason and the anticipated timeframe for the filing.

Enbridge is directed to serve a copy of this letter on Line 9 and Mainline shippers and parties to the RH-3-2008 Proceeding.
